***JR Staff opportunities are also available for 15 an 16 year olds. Contact the Club for more information.**



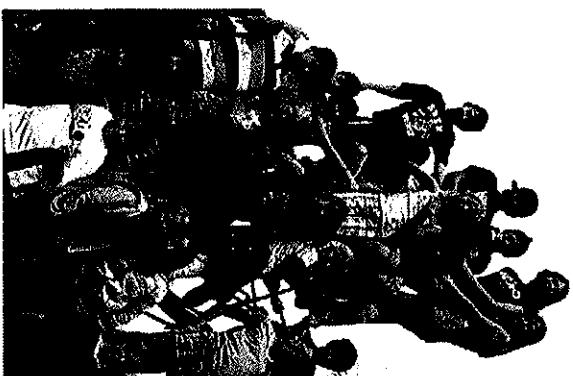
